- What are the latest narcotics used by teens?
- What are the signs of drug use?
- How do parents unknowingly become “passive pushers,” of drugs by overlooking the dangers posed in the medicine cabinet?
- What should you as a Parent do to help their students avoid trouble?
- How can parents get help?

Sgt. Paul R. Kunkel and Officer Leo Capovilla of the San Mateo County Narcotics Task Force will talk about the drug exposure for teens and young adults, including the latest drugs, what parents should do to help their students avoid trouble, what to do if concern exists and how to determine if its does.
