Summer Assignment

Journal (Diario) - Due August 16th – 20 points

In a composition notebook, you will need to write one journal entry per week (a total of 10) for the summer. The purpose of this assignment is not to intrude on your free time, but rather to encourage you to continue actively using your Spanish. It is a much more meaningful task if the journals are done weekly instead of all at once. Please date and number each entry and try to include a variety of verb tenses and vocabulary in each one. Each entry should be close to a page in length. Your journal is due the first day of school.

You will need to find 2 different news articles in Spanish, print them and read them. You will also need to complete the vocabulary and comprehension activities that you will find on the attached worksheet for each article.
